Sub : Compulsory online payment of Commercial Taxes w.e.f. 1/11/2009, by dealers who paid more than Rs. 10 Lakh as tax in 2008-09.

Sir,

The Rules relating to payment of VAT and Sales Tax have recently been amended. As per the amended provisions, where the amount of tax or the aggregate of the amounts of tax, paid by a registered dealer in the year ending on the 31st day of March, 2009 exceeded rupees ten lakh, such registered dealer shall make payment of tax, interest or penalty, payable by, or due from, him under the VAT and ST Acts or rules made thereunder electronically through the concerned web sites of the agency banks on and from the 1st day of November, 2009 until such time the certificate of registration granted to such dealer is cancelled.

- c. Central Bank of India
