

Corrugated board box makers to go strike on Apr 3

Eastern India Corrugated Box Manufactures" Association (EICMA) today announced one-day token strike on April 3 to protest "unjustified and artificial price incease of kraft paper' that causing damage to industry. EICMA president Milan Kumar Dey said the industry, comprising mostly MSME units in West Bengal, Bihar, Jharkhand, Odisha, Sikkim and northeast states have been pressed to the wall by 50 and odd paper mills, who have formed a coterie with profiteering motive and hiking prices almost on weekly basis. "This has resulted in a cumulative 20 to 25 per cent rise across different grades of kraft paper since the last week of January, 2017. UNI PC SJC
